Hello Philip G. Rice:

Thank you for contacting our office with your concerns as we are in receipt of your complaint. Fraud reports enable our office to identify and devote our limited resources to cases supported by law involving widespread harm to Colorado consumers and the associated business environment. Information from the public contributes to potential investigations and may lead to possible legal action taken on behalf of the State of Colorado.

As a result, we will keep the information obtained from your complaint as part of our ongoing efforts to identify businesses that may engage in patterns of deceptive practices in Colorado. While the Colorado Attorney General is chief legal counsel to state government and is responsible for protecting the public interest, the Attorney General is not authorized to serve as legal counsel or advisor to individual citizens and is prohibited in providing legal advice, interpretation, or counsel to private citizens.

Should you desire a legal opinion relating to your specific situation, we also recommend contacting a private attorney or one of the services that provide legal assistance through the local bar association and/or other entities. Even where we cannot take specific action based on your complaint, the fact that you took time to notify us is extremely valuable to our efforts to identify emerging trends and pressing concerns.
